## Volunteer Positions: Descriptions of Duties

### Contestant Registration

The Contestant Registration Volunteers will work contestant registration the evening before the rodeo. Contestant Registration will be held at the rodeo grounds. There are multiple positions available and would be assigned when the Contestant Registration volunteer arrives. The Contestant Registration volunteer would be trained at Contestant Registration. Some of the duties would include basic filing, and filling out forms.

### Chutes/Arena

These two positions are full day volunteer positions and it is preferred that they volunteer for both days as these are both very involved positions. Some instruction will be given during the course of the rodeo and will be under the rules of the IGRA Rules and Regulations required for these positions. These positions may require the wearing of long sleeve western shirts, Wrangler style jeans, cowboy boots, or other enclosed toe boots, and cowboy hat or other hat as outlined in the IGRA Rule Book.

### Chute Crew

Chute Crew is under the direction of the Chute Coordinator and the Assistant Chute Coordinator. The Chute Crew loads stock into the chutes, including bulls, broncs, calves, and steers. Prior experience is preferred but not essential. Because you will be working with wild livestock, it is best that prior livestock knowledge and experience be considered before volunteering for this position.

### Arena Crew

Arena Crew will be under the direction of the Arena Director and the Assistant Arena Director. Prior experience is preferred but not essential. Job duties will include: working with small livestock, setting up, and maintaining the arena for specific events. Some items may be a bit heavy. Knowledge of measuring essentials and use of measuring tools is preferred.

### **Main Gate**

The Main Gate Volunteers are responsible for charging front gate admission; punch all tickets accurately as instructed by the Volunteer Coordinator or the Rodeo Director. Giving change for moneys tendered. They are also responsible for an accurate gate count. Counting of the spectators who buy tickets, those who already have tickets, or complementary tickets received in letter form, and those who arrive by bus. Proper count of the spectators passing through the gate is essential because an accurate count needs to be given to IGRA and to our sponsors for attendance. They will need to send all volunteers who come to the gate to the Volunteer Coordinator at the volunteer booth.
